Sri. Mohammed Qamaruddin, Hon'ble Chairman, Sri. B. Shanker Luke, V.C., Sri. Gusti Noria, Sri. Mohammed Arshad Ali Khan, Sri. B. Kattaiah, Sardar Surender Singh, Dr. Vidya Sravanti Members & Sri. Mohammed Riaz Ahmed, Advisor, of Telangana State Minorities Commission, visited Cherlapalli & Chanchalguda Jail today.


The Hon'ble Chairman Mohammed Qamaruddin, reached at Cherlapalli Jail at 11.15 am and left by 1 pm to visit Chanchalguda Jail.

During his visit he is accompanied by the Jail Superintendent Mr. Bhasker Rao. He explained that the Cherlapalli Jail is located in 147 acres area and buildings were constructed on 47 acres in which Library, Computer Rooms, and other Rooms are housed. There are 7 blocks, each Block with Capacity to house 200 Prisoners, 12 Dormitory, Meeting Rooms with well furnished lights, fans, toilets, clean and green, Well furnished Libraries. At the time of Commission's visit there are two Doctors available. Separate Rooms were provided for worship for the Prisoners from the Minority Communities. In this Jail those prisoners who are sentences for more than 2 years are only kept. The Jail Superintendent further explained to the Chairman Mohammed Qamaruddin, that now the total strength of prisoners are 1800 – 1920, out of which 200 are Muslim, Minorities, 110 are Christians and the rest are others. In this Jail more than 500 persons are studying in different courses, like, B.A., B.Sc, B.Com & M.A, M.Com through Open University. This year the passing average was 70% in different courses. In P.G Course all 13 prisoners passed Out of 13.

The Jail Superintendent also showed them the industries where prisoners are producing Vegetables, Cotton, making Almirahs & Wooden furniture, manufacturing Unit of National Phenyl, National Soaps etc.,

The Hon'ble Chairman Mohammed Qamaruddin also met with the Prisoners i.e. one Shareef, Fasih & Singh and asked about the food & accommodation provided to them. They said that Food and accommodation is good and satisfactory. That the Jail Superintendent and the staffs are co operating with them. The Hon'ble Chairman also noted that the Premises of Cherlapalli Jail is very neat and clean more than his expectation and appreciated.
