The 5<sup>th</sup> board meeting of the Hyderabad Road development Corporation limited held today under the chairmanship of the Chief Secretary Dr S K Joshi approved the architectural drawings of the iconic pedestrian bridge opposite to Salarjung Museum at an estimated cost of Rs 231.50 crores. It also includes proposed multilevel car parking at Quliqu tub Shah complex and construction of additional bridge for accommodating fruit vendors in between Nayapul and its adjoining bridge. The consultants submitted the revised layouts, architectural plan and detailed project report which were placed before the board of directors for approval and to invite tenders on EPC mode.
