

## **BRIEF NOTE ON RESIDENTIAL EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS SOCIETIES SPORTS LEAGUE**

Telangana Government is taking several measures for the Social, Educational and Economic growth by providing better and quality education to the children belonging to down trodden communities of SC, ST, BC, Minority and Economically Backward students of other communities.

After formation of Telangana State, Government have taken initiation to establish more number of Residential Schools. At present (840) Residential Schools, Junior and Degree Colleges are functioning under the control of various Societies as shown below.

About 3,00,000 students are pursuing their studies in the above institutions. An average of Rs.1.25 Lakhs on each student per annum is being incurred by the Government.

In addition to free and quality education in English medium, the students are being provided the following amenities and facilities.

Special coaching is being provided to attend the competitive examinations like IIT, NEET, EAMCET and CACPT, duly establishing Centers of Excellence. In addition, Summer camps are being conducted to provide special coaching in Leadership skills, Soft skills, Communication skills, Spoken English, Dance, Drama and Photography etc., to the selected students. With the efforts made by the Societies, the students are achieving better results in SSC, Inter and Degree level than other Government and Private institutions in the State. The Residential institutions students are also achieving good ranks in IIT, NEET, EAMCET and getting admissions in other prestigious institutes in India.

The holistic growth as well as develop the various facets of the personality development of the children; classroom teaching shall be supplemented with co-curricular activities. These out of class activities affect all domains of life such as cognitive, emotional, social, moral, cultural and aesthetic. To encourage sports spirit among the students, all Societies conducting Sports meets to their students at School level, Zonal level and State level separately for Boys and Girls, with which many students are selected for various Sports and Games at State, National and International level.
